

***Please note that these programs are available to Aboriginal students only**

Those wishing to apply to Indigenous Diploma Programs must first apply through the Ontario Universities Application Centre (www.ouac.on.ca). Once that application is made, we require additional information in order to assess your eligibility to the program:

- 1) A cover letter answering the following questions:
 - a) Why do you want to attend University?
 - b) What skills and experience do you have that'll help you be successful in University?
- 2) A current resume;
- 3) Students not currently in high school will need to submit a sealed transcript (as directed on OUAC) which has come directly from all previous high schools and post-secondary institutions. (if you are a current high school student, your transcript will be sent automatically through OUAC);
- 4) Two referees/references. (students currently in high schools must provide at least one academic reference from their high school);

All this information must be received in order for us to decide on your eligibility for the program. An assessment will not be made until your file is complete. Please note that an admissions interview may also be required. Indigenous diploma program applications can be mailed, emailed, or faxed.
